In the group of Prof. Chuan He at the University of Chicago in the area of biochemistry, proteomics and structural biology.

1. Biochemistry of actinides

A postdoctoral fellowship funded by The Camille & Henry Dreyfus Foundation to develop proteins/microbes that can selectively recognize actinide elements under environmental aqueous conditions. The candidate should have strong academic backgrounds. Previous research experiences in biochemistry or coordination chemistry are preferred.

2. Proteomics

We invite highly qualified individuals with a Ph.D. in biochemistry/proteomics/cell biology to join an exciting research program. This is joint effort between two laboratories at the University of Chicago and Argonne National Laboratory to utilize 2-D gel and radioactive elements for identification of novel metalloproteins. The candidate should have extensive research experiences in 2-D gel and related biochemistry or cell biology studies.
